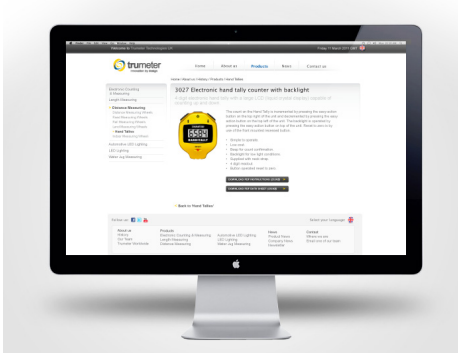
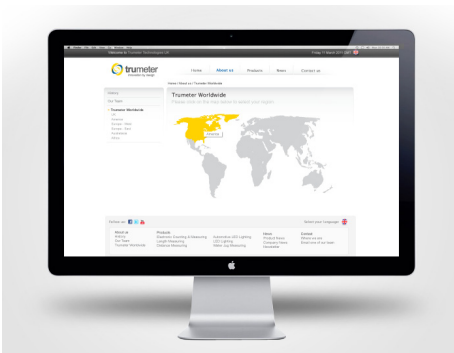

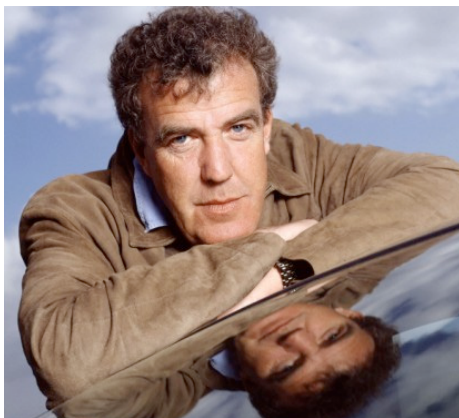
New Trumeter Website goes live
